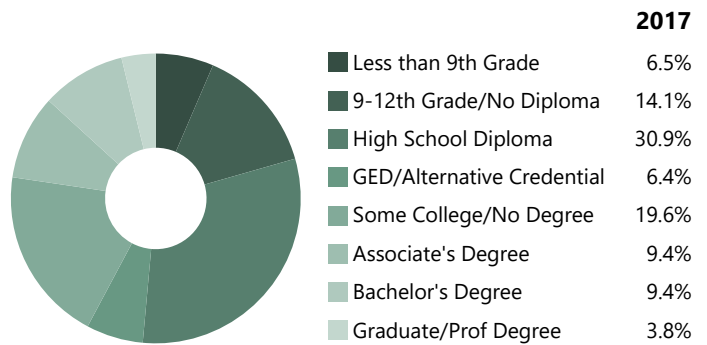

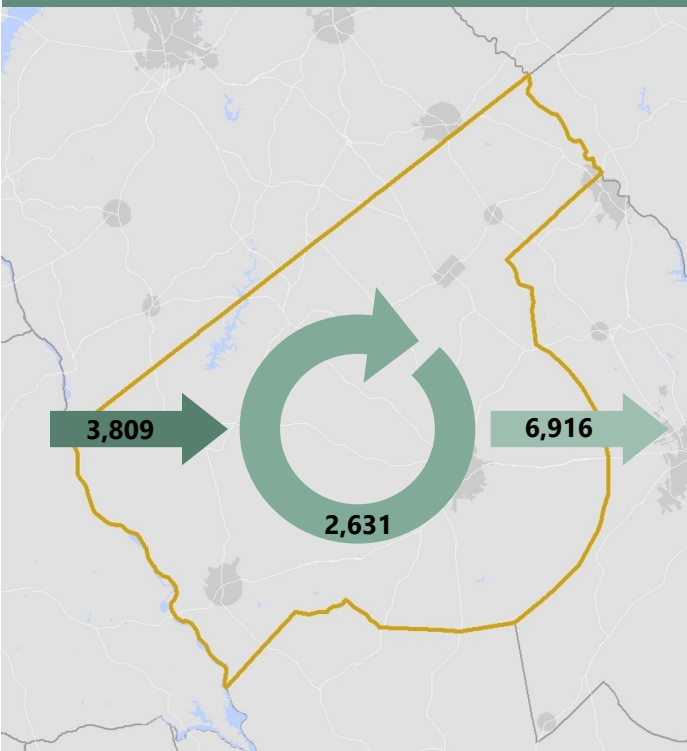

Both the county and its county seat were named for the French town of the same name. Originally part of Ninety-Six District, the area was designated as Abbeville County in 1785. Located along the "Freshwater Coast," Abbeville County is settled at the state's western boundary.
